PROCEDURE OF RECOGNITION AT EOF'S LEVELS 1 AND 2

Identify/Define the processes and procedures by which non-formal and informal learning could be recognised at levels 1 and 2 of the EQF: mutual learning workshops to discover innovative mechanisms for the assessment of learning outcomes in formal, non-formal and informal vocational training systems;

Development of a model for positioning formative and summative evaluations of partner countries at levels 1 and 2 of the qualifications frameworK

PRACTICAL GUIDE

To permit the positioning of Learning outcomes at level 1 and 2 of the National Qualification Framework (based on the European Qualification Framework)
